Cappelletti foursome wins Open Swiss

The team captained by Mike Cappelletti survived a final-round loss to capture the Open Swiss Teams by .59 Victory Points. Cappelletti, Gary Cohler, Richard Finberg and Mark Lair lost their last match, 16-0, and might have surrendered first place to the team that beat them – Rose Johnson-Meltzer, Peter Weichsel, Alan Sontag, Kyle Larsen, Chip Martel and Lew Stansby – but the margin wasn't enough for the other team to move into first. The Johnson-Meltzer team ended up second.

Eythorsdottir squad takes Women's Swiss

In second place with a round to go, the squad led by Hjordis Eythorsdottir earned just enough Victory Points to overtake the first-place team and win the Women's Swiss Teams. Eythorsdottir, Valerie Westheimer, Judy Wadas, Linda Lewis and Karen Barrett ended up 1.58 VPs ahead of Kathie-Wei Sender, Betty Ann Kennedy, Juanita Chambers, Jill Levin, Janice Seamon-Molson and Tobi Sokolow -- the leaders with one round to go.

Hindman, Chen runaway victors in NAOP B

Hal Hindman of Fairfax VA and Mark Chen of Falls Church VA, representing District 6, were the victors in Flight B of the North American Pairs. They led after the qualifying and then added two fine sessions to finish first with a score of 451.03 and win by almost three full boards -- a very fine performance.

Tien-Chun Yang and Fang Wu of San Jose CA, representing District 21, had a score of 413.18, usually good enough to win, but this time it was good enough only for second. Another board back in third place were District 4 representatives Joseph Torelli of Newtown PA and Everett Young of Lafayette Hill PA.

Munafu now Grand LM

Paul Munafu of Huntsville recently became a Grand Life Master (10,000 masterpoints and at least one North American championship). He had a good tournament at the Huntsville Sectional just before coming to Cincinnati. His NABC victory occurred in 1988 when he won the North American Swiss.

Munafu began his bridge career in 1963, but he plays little these days. His job as deputy manager for materials, processes and manufacturers with NASA keeps him too busy to spend much time playing bridge.

His favorite partners over the years include Curtis Cheek, Larry Sealy, Randy Pettit and Kathie Wei-Sender.

Meredith Beck, 14, of Pearland TX and John Johnson of Houston rallied strongly in the final of Flight C of the North American Open Pairs. They went into the final in sixth place, then had two good sessions to bring the championship to District 16.

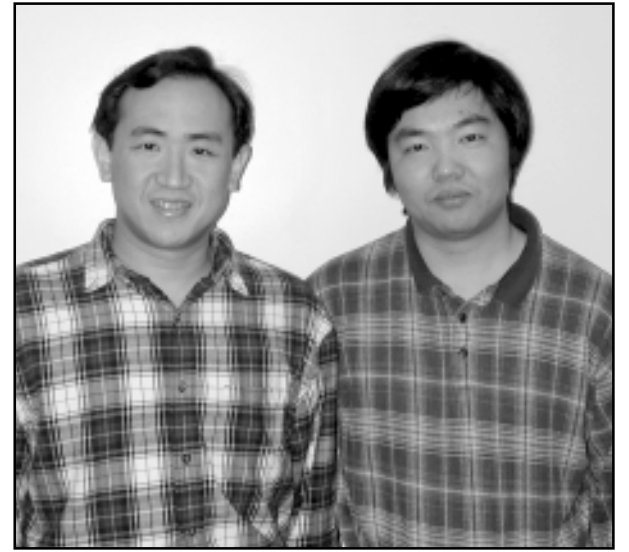

Every shot makes somebody happy

Sheila and Mark had a solid afternoon session in the Open Pairs, but they were a fair distance behind the leaders. But then she got the "happy" news that both of her boys' Vanderbilt teams were getting blown out in the semifinals. See what we mean? She was happy (actually she wasn't - she wanted them to win) and her three potential teammates were sad.

Sheila and Mark had a huge evening session, good enough to move into the tie for the championship. And the two Vanderbilt teams lost, so her St. Patrick's Day delivered her both an Open Pairs victory and the Swiss team she wanted.
