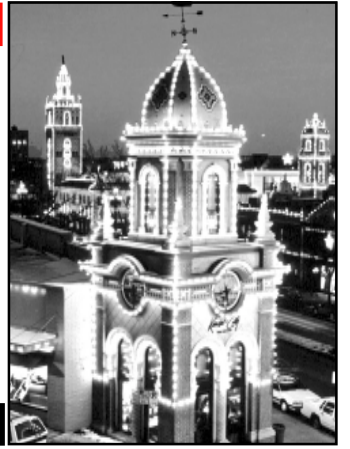

Goodwill honors Virgil Anderson

Virgil Anderson, District 15 director to the ACBL Board of Directors and a member of the World Bridge Federation Executive Council, received the accolades of his peers yesterday as he was honored at the meeting of the ACBL Goodwill Committee. Anderson also is a past president of the ACBL.

"Dedicated volunteers are hard to come by," said Joan Gerard, District 3 Board representative

and former ACBL president. "I cannot think of anyone more dedicated and more efficient than Virgil Anderson."

Jayne Thomas, former District 9 Board representative, called Anderson her best friend. Then she joked, "I haven't had a bad board with him for a long time - let's see, I think it was Round 9 this afternoon." Actually Anderson and Thomas

Fred Hamilton and Steve Catlett, a first-time partnership, had two strong final sessions to win the Silver Ribbon Pairs by almost two full boards.

Ethan Stein and Gerald Caravelli were second. This was the straight third year that Caravelli has been second in the event, each time with a different partner.

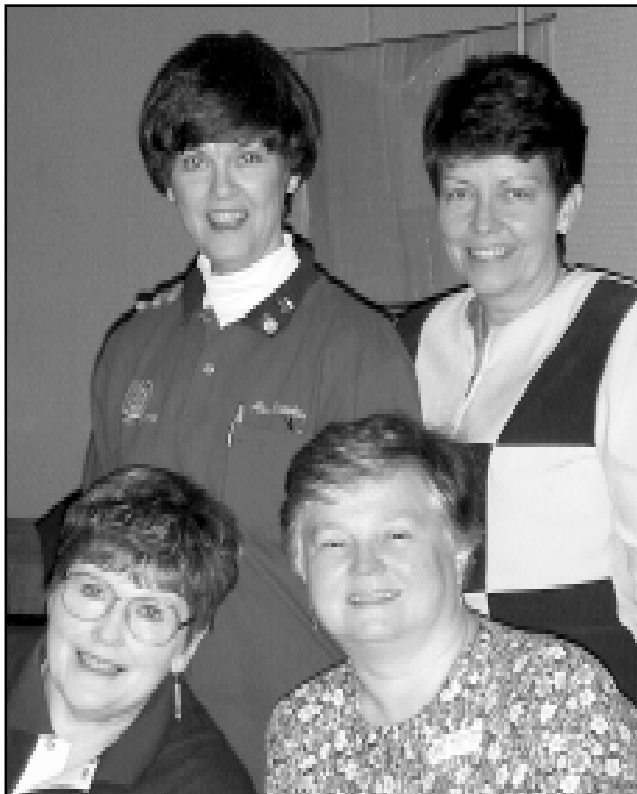
Catlett won his second North American championship. He won the Life Master Open Pairs with Paul Soloway in 1999. "Fact is," he said, "Mr. Soloway put us together for this event."

Hamilton, who has two firsts and two seconds in international competition plus numerous North American championships, observed, "Yesterday he (Catlett) wasn't as focused as he wanted to be. He told me he'd be better today - and he was."

Hamilton added, "Winning doesn't get old - it just gets harder."

I/N speakers teach, entertain

Every card you play as a defender sends a message to partner, says the speaker, who urges the Intermediate/Newcomer players to "think defense."

Barbara Seagram, one of the participants in the Intermediate/Newcomer Speakers Program, tells her audience of about 100 players to remember: "each card that you play can send only one message. The ♠2 simply says, don't continue; make an intelligent shift.

"It does not say," she adds, "don't continue spades but shift to clubs."

Seagram refers to a hand-out given to all the players and asks, "On problem 1, you lead the ♣A and partner plays the ♣2. How many vote to continue clubs?"

Aggressive bidding pays off for Juniors

Aggressive bidding at both tables made the difference in the match between Kathie Weisender and a batch of Juniors captained by Joel Wooldridge.. At one table a Junior responded to partner's opening bid with just one jack. At the other table a Junior threw in a vulnerable preemptive jump overcall on a jack-high suit with a king-jack outside.

After Gavin Wolpert opened 1♣, Joe Grue decided that his five-card suit was worth bidding even if he had only one high card point. Wolpert of course was overjoyed and trotted out Blackwood. Juanita Chambers decided to respond to Peggy Sutherlin's takeout double since all her length and strength were in the red suits. She chose to bid her four-card diamond suit instead of her heart six-carder. Actually she was on the right track – 7♦ goes down only four – 1100 – on a club lead and much less, probably only two for minus 500 on any other lead. Grue doubled to show no key cards. Wolpert told about his heart control, but of course Grue had nothing to add. So Wolpert signed off in 6♠. With the ♣K onside, Grue had no problem taking 12 tricks.

Here it was Wooldridge who was aggressive. His overcall made it difficult, nearly impossible for Janice Seamon-Molson to take action. Brad Campbell showed a good hand and a good fit with his 3♣ cuebid, but Tobi Sokolow had no problem leaping to the spade game. Molson still had no good reason to bid, so that's where the bidding ended. Sokolow also had no problem with the play, but that was 13 IMPs to the Juniors. They went on to win, 180-149, and advance to the Round of 64.

Sitting out during this portion of the 64-board match were Wei-Sender and Kent Mignocchi.

Do I have a choice?

Mel Colchamiro cornered me on my way to the elevator and gave me a beautiful hand. Beware, it's far harder than it looks but it is far from complicated.

♠ J 7 3

Without going into too many details – we would not want to embarrass any guilty parties – consider the play in 6♠.

Best defense is obviously to lead two rounds of clubs but your generous opponents play a top club and shift to diamonds. Obviously they believe you might bid a slam off two aces; it is up to you to punish them for such an insult.

The natural thing to do is to cash the ♠A and the ♥K. Then you lead the ♠10 from hand.

If West discards, you need the ♥Q to fall. If West follows, guess whether trumps are splitting or whether hearts behave. That looks pretty good but it is far from best.

The winning line is to overtake the ♥K with the ♥A at trick two and ruff a heart. If that suit splits or if the ♥Q is bare, you have no problem in drawing trumps, ending in dummy. If hearts do not behave, you need 2-2 spades – it's as simple as that.

With a little help

Howard Einberg of Los Angeles, playing with Hideki Takano of Toyko in the second qualifying session of Open Pairs I, needed a little help from his opponents to score up his notrump game.

South led the ♠Q and Einberg won his king. He led a low club and South hopped up with his ace. He cashed the ♠A and North pitched a heart. South shifted to a heart and Einberg reasoned that South would have cleared spades if he'd held the ♠A.

He won the heart shift with dummy's jack and led a club to his queen. A diamond went to dummy's king and North decided to duck. Einberg decided to play South for the doubleton ♦10 or ♦J. Accordingly, he stripped out clubs and hearts and led a diamond.

If South had the hoped-for doubleton ♦10 or ♦J, Einberg would duck and South would have to give him a ninth trick in spades. When South followed with a low diamond, Einberg played low from dummy. North could win two diamond tricks but would have to give the last trick to dummy's ♦Q. Making 3NT for plus 400 and most of the matchpoints.

Terry Crabbs of Kansas City, playing in Friday's Stratified Board-a-Match Teams, led the ♠K and declarer won dummy's ace. He merrily cross-ruffed, reaching this position:

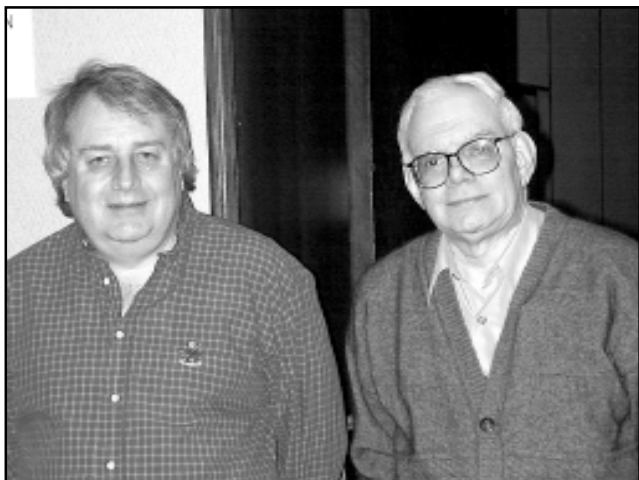

Declarer led the ♣Q and ruffed with dummy's ♠J. East overruffed with the ♠A and returned a heart. Declarer ruffed with his last diamond and led the ♣A, ruffed by Crabbs with the ♠4.

Declarer made his contract for plus 750 and could have made an overtrick either by drawing trumps or by cashing the ♣A early on. That would have given him a score of plus 950 but it was a losing cause – Crabbs' teammates bid the diamond slam and were plus 1370.

Zero Tolerance plan makes a difference

Aileen Osofsky, chairman of the Goodwill Committee, observed at yesterday's meeting that player deportment and conduct at tournaments has shown a major improvement since the advent of the Zero Tolerance policy. ACBL President Jim Kirkham backed her up solidly, saying, "Zero Tolerance is a great success. The games have become more friendly and less contentious. Now it's time to attack slow play."

CEO David Silber of the ACBL reported that membership has turned the corner. There was a fractional gain in membership in 2000. Over the past six months, there has been a small increase each month in comparison with last year's figures. Silber believes the emphasis on goodwill has been a major factor in the turnaround.

Partnership Chairman Chris Ward has been instrumental in teaching and encouraging her high school students to take up duplicate bridge. She has been quite successful in this area.

Goodwill committee

Aileen Osofsky, chairman of the Goodwill Committee since 1985, has changed the committee function in many ways. Prior to 1985 the committee was not an active force in the bridge world.

Aileen changed all that by holding special meetings with a full-fledged interesting program at all NABCs, by selecting a Goodwill Member of the Year, and by working with other groups to improve the general atmosphere of tournaments and the demeanor of the players.

However, she can't do all this by herself. She has surrounded herself with an able group of assistant chairmen. They are Judy Kay for the East, George Rosenkranz for Mexico, Penny Augustine for Eastern Canada, Aidan Ballantyne for Western Canada, Korene Geffen for the West, Sharon David for the Southwest and Carol Sanders for the Southeast.

Norwegian Twins

For several years in the Nineties, a series of articles by Brian Glubok appeared in Bridge Today magazine featuring a pair of deals with similar themes: Twins. Now here in Kansas City, Brian resumes the series with co-author Lindsay Pearlman. 16 years old and a great Junior prospect, Lindsay has already won a regional knockout here in K.C. A twin herself, Lindsay comes from a bridge-playing family. Her mother is an ACBL Life Master and her father is a strong touring pro from the East Coast.

On the diagrammed deal from the final of Open Pairs I, Marinesa Letizia and I squared off against Norwegian superstar Geir Helgemo and New England veteran Richard Zeckhauser.

After a low spade lead, Zeckhauser carefully unblocked the ♠8 under Letizia's jack. The defense shifted to clubs and Zeckhauser won the second round with his ace. He now played the ♠10 from hand, covered by the queen and ace. A diamond to the ace was followed by a third round of spades where declarer led his carefully preserved ♠2 towards dummy's king-7. I played the 6 and after the tiniest flicker Zeckhauser successfully hooked the 7. The high spade was followed by a diamond finesse for eight tricks and an excellent score.

"Geir made a play like that with an old partner of mine -- he extended his life two months...." I commented.

To find that deal, I had to do a quick search on the internet. The key suit on that occasion was AK62 opposite 973. www.google.com Search for Helgemo + Kaplan + IBPA award.

Allow me to set the scene. Dallas, March 1997. The Jacoby Teams (four-session national Swiss at the Spring NABC) was due to start the following afternoon and I cornered Geir in the hotel lobby. He had little interest in playing until I mentioned that we would be teaming with Edgar Kaplan. "I think perhaps I will join your team," Geir agreed.

We qualified in the middle of the pack. "Perhaps you two should play a match before Geir has to fly back to Norway," I suggested to Geir and Kaplan after our second-round match. They were both keen, and it was in that third-round battle that the historic deal occurred. Excuse me while I do a quick search on the internet to find the precise deal.

Bridge Quiz Answers

Sharif has been prominent on stage and screen for many years. He won a Golden Globe Award in 1963 and was nominated for an Oscar for Best Supporting Actor in 1963 for *Lawrence of Arabia*. He is one of the most active promoters of bridge, with many public and TV appearances. His most famous quote: "Acting is my business, bridge is my passion."

He represented the United Arab Republics in the 1964 World Team Olympiad. He was playing captain for Egypt in the 1968 World Team Olympiad. And now that he lives in France, he has represented that country in many international competitions.

He has been involved in many other bridge activities. He organized the Sharif Bridge Circus and was the backbone of the Sharif Individual. He played on Italy's Blue Team and Lancia Team, so perhaps it would be correct to say he represented four countries in international competition.

Geir was in a slam that appeared to require a 3-3 split in that side suit.

Lindsay's comment: "That's a weird auction, but I think I would bid only five diamonds."

My comment: "Roth always said that when the opponents preempt you should always play your partner for seven or eight points."

A club lead would have left declarer with no hope, but the actual lead was the ♥K. After drawing trumps, Geir led towards dummy's 973 of clubs. When West ducked (with 8 doubleton he didn't appear to have many options), Geir inserted dummy's 7. Helgemo had visualized several four-two club splits that would allow him to make the slam. Any of these holdings in the West hand could be compromised by Helgemo's intra-finesse: Q8, J8, 108, 86, 85, and 84.

When the 7 forced the 10, East tried to force the issue by returning the suit before Helgy (Zia's nickname for the Norwegian phenom) could get any additional count on the hand. Undaunted, Geir ducked the trick, winning dummy's 9 and making an apparently impossible slam.

The story has several happy endings. Our team won the event, the last of more than a score of national championships won by bridge legend Kaplan. Edgar commented immediately, "With that play you've extended my life by months." Terminally weak from the illness that would claim his life six months later, Kaplan returned to New York and wrote the hand up for the international bridge press and for his own bridge magazine (*Bridge World*). For that fine play Geir won the 1997 International Bridge Press Association Award for the best played hand of the year.

While Geir's play might have failed against such mundane distributions as J82 with West and Q105 with East, his play was a stand-out on the bidding, since the club length was almost certainly with East.

Only one small question remains: If West had played the ♠8 on the first round of the suit, would Geir have still made the slam by playing him for 8-small? Perhaps Helgy would have played an honor on the second round of the suit, catering to queen-8, jack-8 or 10-8 on his left.

Knowing how much Geir wanted to win that day with Kaplan, I imagine he would have made whichever play was the winner at the table.

A small handful of players raise their hands.

"How many vote to shift?"

A larger group holds up their hands.

"Do you want to shift to a heart? That's trumps."

Few hands go up.

"Good. Now how about diamonds? Dummy has the ace, king, queen."

No hands.

"Very good. Shall we shift to a spade?"

This time, the agreement is near unanimous.

"That's settled. We'll shift to a spade. Our holding is 9-5-3. What should we lead? The 9? The 3?"

There are scattered votes for each. "When sending a message to partner," says Seagram, "remember BOSTON: bottom of something, top of nothing -- and that's how the city got its name."

On defense, says Seagram, "your objective is to hurt, maim and destroy -- with a smile. You kill your opponents with kindness."

"We love leading short suits -- we'd lead a void if we could."

As Seagram finishes speaking, players gather around her -- some asking questions, others saying thanks. It's a scene repeated twice a day during the North American Bridge Championships. The talks are aimed at the I/N players but attract players of all experience levels.

Average attendance is about 100 for each session. Speakers here in Kansas City have been John Herrmann, Harriette Buckman, Bruce Reeve, Jerry Helms, Ken Monzingo, Larry Cohen, Don Stack and Curtis Cheek.

Seagram, Monday afternoon's speaker, is from Toronto where she is the owner/manager of Kate Buckman's Bridge Studio, one of North America's largest. She was one of the developers of Zero Tolerance, ACBL's official policy at NABCs.

Scheduled the rest of the week are Alan LeBendig and Jade Barrett, Tuesday; Shannon Cappelletti and Michael Huston, Wednesday; Zeke Jabbour and Lowell Andrews, Thursday; Billy Miller and Harold Feldheim, Friday; and Brad Furnish and Max Hardy, Saturday.

Speakers are scheduled at 12:15 p.m. and 7:15 p.m. daily in Century C at the Westin.

The program was established in the early Eighties as part of the I/N program developed by Edith McMullin. The late Ron Andersen was a regular -- in fact, he usually spoke twice during each NABC.

I/N director Judy Cotterman has been scheduling speakers for the last few years and has added a regional slant -- Florida speakers at Florida NABCs, Kansas and Missouri speakers here in Kansas City.

In addition, several members of the ACBL Board of Directors -- Buckman, Reeve, LeBendig plus ACBL president Jim Kirkham and former president Howard Piltch -- are regular speakers. "Personally, I think this is one of the most important things we do," says Reeve.

Blubaugh suspended

The ACBL has suspended John Blubaugh from all ACBL play from March 14, 2001, through September 13, 2002, because of card manipulation during the shuffle and deal. He was found guilty of giving his partner a specific card when he was the dealer. The Board of Directors sustained the decision of the Ethical Oversight Committee on this matter. Blubaugh attempted to have a restraining order placed on the suspension, but the judge at the hearing refused to issue the order.

According to the minutes of the ACBL Board, this is the punishment imposed on Blubaugh:

Blubaugh is suspended from the ACBL effective March 14, 2001 through September 13, 2002.

Upon completion of the suspension, Blubaugh will be placed on probation through September 12, 2007, during which time he shall not be allowed to shuffle and/or deal a hand in ACBL-sanctioned competition.

All masterpoints won by him for the period March 15, 2000, through March 14, 2001, shall be removed from his record.

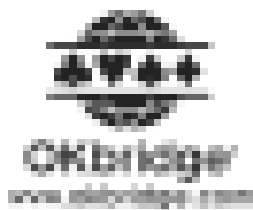
