Bartusek, Jones win Bruce LM Pairs

The winners of the David Bruce LM-5000 Life Master Pairs are Mark Bartusek and John Jones. Bartusek, of Santa Barbara CA, and Jones, of Hacienda Heights CA, paired a huge 71.27% in the first final session with a 47.80% in the second final (a "nightmare session" according to Bartusek) to finish on top by half a board. Their final score was 422.56.

In second with 416.87 (top was 13) was Craig Zastera of Woodinville WA and Stan Christie of Des Moines WA, both in the Seattle area.

Bartusek, a software engineer for Raytheon, is a member of the National Appeals Committee and is a frequent participant in *The Bridge World's* Master Solvers Club. He is also poker enthusiast

Baseball on ground, bridge in the air

Bridge apparently has a special attraction for baseball players. Many players in the Big Show (the major leagues) play bridge to while away their free time on planes and in hotels.

One of the competitors at this tournament is Wes Parker, the storied first baseman for the Dodgers from 1964 to 1972. When he was on the ground, he was winning six Golden Glove awards for his outstanding fielding. But when he was in the air, he was playing bridge.

Like a good son, Parker followed his father's advice: "Learn how to play golf and bridge. They're the best social games of them all. You'll meet lots of wonderful people when you play golf and bridge." Parker got this advice when he was in high school, and he immediately took up golf.

He took up bridge in 1963. He vividly recalls going to a regional in Honolulu back then. "It was so exciting. I met Eddie Kantar there. And I had the chance to watch Charles Goren and Helen Sobel play together. It was fascinating."

Freeman, Nickell snag LM crown

Nick Nickell and Richard Freeman are well known to the bridge community for their multiple team championships on the national and world level, but last evening the duo added a new type of laurel to their bridge crowns by winning the von Zedtwitz Life Master Pairs. Although Nickell has one previous NABC pairs victory (the 1991 Blue Ribbon Pairs playing with Bob Hamman), this is Freeman's first.

The winners' final score of 1324.55 was almost 2.5 boards ahead of the runners-up, Michael Rosenberg and Ralph Katz. Rosenberg, of Wykagyl NY, and Katz, of Hinsdale IL, posted a score of 1232.21. (Top on a board was 38.)

In third were Larry Cohen and David Berkowitz with 1221.68.

Nickell, of New York NY, and Freeman, of Atlanta GA, led the event at the end of Saturday's semifinal round, and maintained their lead throughout Sunday's final. Nickell and Freeman scored 63.56% in the first final session, and 60.63% in the second final session in which no other pair ever challenged the winners' two-board lead.

Said Freeman, "If you just take your aces and kings and bid your games and slams, you'd be surprised how well you do. You don't have to be a genius to win."

Nickell and Freeman are part of a team that will represent the U.S. in the Bermuda Bowl later this year. Nickell is the captain.

The six-session Life Master Pairs is played for the von Zedtwitz Gold Cup.

Your chance for international fame

Even if you didn't qualify for the Bermuda Bowl or Venice Cup this year, there is still a world championship open to you this fall.

It's the World Transnational Open Teams, played alongside the Bermuda Bowl and Venice Cup at the Generali World Bridge Championships in Monte Carlo, Nov. 2-15.

The transnational event — meaning anyone can play with anyone, regardless of home country — begins Nov. 10 and concludes on Nov. 15.

It's your chance to visit one of the most beautiful areas in the world — the Principality of Monaco on the French Riviera — and play in the same tournament as the superstars.

In fact, four members of the winning team from 2001 are Americans: Eddie Wold, Mike Passell, Michael Seamon and Geoff Hampson. They played with Brazil's Gabriel Chagas and Diego Brenner. Malcolm Brachman was captain.

Teams in the transnational event will play 15 10-board matches in a Swiss format, followed by the quarterfinal knockout phase. The semifinal KO will be on Nov. 14, the final the following day.

The entry fee for the World Transnational Open Teams is \$800 (U.S.) per team. Send your entry fee and list of players to the World Bridge Federation, 40 rue Francois 1er, F-75008, Paris, France.

7 GNT victories for Martel, Stansby, Ross

Three members of the District 21 (California) Grand National Teams champions have a truly exotic record in this event – Chip Martel, Lew Stansby and Hugh Ross have won this event seven times since 1982.

A freak hand that occurred in the final quarter against the District 9 (Florida) team caused some wild bidding at one table and produced a simple result at the other.

The Martel-Stansby style is to open 1♣ with a 4-5 minor suiter. Martel's 1♣ certainly sounded good to Stansby. Eric Rodwell announced his red two-suiter, and Stansby told a little bit about his spades. But the big surprise was when Jeff Meckstroth jumped to 5♦. He was quite sure that his side had 12 hearts, so he didn't want to bid that suit because he feared that it would spur his opponents to bid more and more spades.

Martel of course doubled, but who can blame Stansby for thinking that his hand was not all that great defensively? Stansby ran to 5♠. Now it was time for Martel to figure out what was going on. Meckstroth had not bid hearts, so it was clear that Stansby had some, probably four. He also had a raft of spades to justify his pull of the double, so chances were that he had only a singleton club. If that were the case, a spade slam looked real good, so Martel bid it.

Rodwell wanted a club lead, so he doubled. But now Meckstroth had a problem. He was sure his side could collect a club trick, but he knew something Rodwell didn't know – his side was NOT going to get a heart trick. So he pulled the double to 7♥, which Martel doubled.

Martel led a spade, so eventually the defense collected a spade and two diamonds for plus 800. It's a good thing that Martel didn't start with top diamonds and then lead a third for his partner to ruff. Trumping in with a void trump suit just doesn't work.

At the other table North-South stopped in 5♠, making six. Making six? Yes! East's opening lead with the ♣K!

That was 3 IMPs to California. If Meckstroth had passed the double, his side would have gained 13 IMPs – but that still would not have been enough to change the final result – California still would have won by 3 IMPs.

The next-to-last deal found Martel in a difficult spade game.

The 3NT bid was a mild slam try. Rodwell led the ♦J and Martel called for the ace. He hoped to be able to pitch his clubs on the hearts, but Meckstroth ruffed the second round of the suit with the 9 and Martel overruffed with the queen. He led the ♦Q to Meckstroth's king, and back came a low club. After a good deal of thought, Martel decided Meckstroth was underleading his ace, so he went up with the king. This worked and he led the good ♦9, hoping Rodwell would forget to ruff so that dummy's clubs could be sluffed. But not surprisingly Rodwell ruffed in with the jack as dummy discarded a club. Rodwell led a club to partner's ace, and Meckstroth led a diamond, ruffed in dummy. At last Martel took the spade finesse, and he chalked up his game when it succeeded.

Cohen, Cohen, Gone!

We played a knockout match on Saturday that might be described as a triumph in declarer play futility. Twenty-eight deals and only three making contracts! In fact even the partscore records were quite dismal— between the two sides we made one three-level contract and one two-level contract!

So the games that did make were going to be absolutely critical. On the deal that follows, our opponents had done the best they could, so we were rather nervous.

At our table Rebecca Gough (one of this tournament's indefatigable organizers) had opened 1♦ as North and saved in 5♦. We led a heart to the ace and shifted to a club. Declarer guessed the diamonds for down one.

Since 4♥ by West figures to make – except on the impossible low spade lead – we were in some jeopardy with our plus 100. However, at the other table, where Ralph Cohen was playing with Marvin Shapiro, this was their auction:

Can you blame West for leading the ♠4? Cohen played low from dummy, forcing the 10 to his king. He gave up a heart and won the club shift with the ace. Next came the ♠A and the ♠J, pinning West's 9. East covered of course, so Cohen ruffed, trumped a heart and cashed the ♠8 to pitch his club loser. When the 3-0 trump break came to light, Cohen could not mis-guess trumps. Plus 550 and a 12-IMP pickup. That was enough to see us home in the match.

Less and less

The opening bidder said 1♥ and this was followed by two passes. The player in the passout position overcalled 1NT. When asked the point range, he replied, "12-15." Opener rebid his hearts, and the notrumper's partner won the contract with his 2♠ bid.

Afterwards the 1NT bidder indignantly said to his partner, "We agreed 11-15."

"You're right! I forgot!"

"OK," said the notrump bidder, "I had 10."

A grand inference — literally!

The District 16 (Texas) squad of Buddy Hanby, Sally Wheeler, and Jim and Patricia Griffin won the Grand National Teams, Flight A on Saturday.

Hanby made a nice inference on this deal from the final match to bring home a grand slam:

West led the ♠9. Declarer would have no problems if both black suits behave, but the 5-1 spade division killed any hope of establishing the suit for a diamond pitch from the closed hand.

Hanby won the ♠A, drew trumps ending in dummy and ruffed a spade to discover the bad split. He now had to rely on a diamond finesse to get home. But which opponent should he play for the jack?

Hanby reasoned that enemy hearts were probably 5-6 or 6-5 (no preempting). Since East was known at this point to have five spades and one club, that meant his likely pattern was 5-5-2-1 or perhaps 5-6-1-1. West, therefore was much more likely to have diamond length. Hanby backed his judgment by cashing the ♦K and running the ♦10 through West. Making seven for plus 2140 was a 13-IMP pickup when North-South at the other table stopped in 6♣.

8 ever, 9 never? Not every time!

When you get fixed because the opponents are lucky, it's not a good feeling. When you get fixed because the opponents did something good, you still don't feel so good, but that doesn't stop you from congratulating your opponent for a fine play. That's what happened on this deal from the second semifinal session of the Life Master Pairs.

After Bart Starr showed two key cards without the trump queen in response to Blackwood, Howard Perlman leaped to the heart grand slam. Perlman hasn't been playing that much lately, but his play of this deal shows he still knows how to make a thoughtful decision.

He won the club opening lead, checked the trumps by leading a heart to the ace, and then got back to his hand with the ♠A. He led a second heart — and finessed the 10! That was it — 7♥ bid and made.

Sidney Lazard, North, raised his eyebrows when Perlman called for the ♥10. Perlman turned to him and said, "You didn't lead a trump." It's true, the most common opening lead against a grand slam in a suit is a trump in an attempt to avoid giving anything away with a side suit lead. Lazard didn't lead a trump, so Perlman decided Lazard's reason probably was because he held the queen. He acted successfully on this assumption.

Lazard and his partner, Bart Bramley, congratulated Perlman on his fine decision. However, they weren't too happy when they discovered they had failed to qualify for the final. If Perlman had played for the drop, the extra matchpoints would have been more than enough for Lazard and Bramley to qualify.

Zia gets into the story, too. Once he was asked what his opening lead would be against a grand slam where the bidding pinpointed that the ace and king of trumps were on his left. He said he would lead away from his queen-third. When everyone looked at him open-mouthed, he said, "Believe me, there'll never play me for the queen. They'll play for the drop and I'll get my queen for the setting trick."

ABTA announces annual book, software winners

The American Bridge Teachers Association (ABTA) concluded its 46th annual convention at the Long Beach NABC, and at the awards banquet held on July 17, announced its annual award winners for the following categories:

The ABTA Book of the Year Award for the Intermediate/Advanced category went to 25 Steps to Learning 2/1 by Paul Thurston (Masterpoint Press). The ABTA Book of the Year Award for the Beginner/Novice category went to Bridge Basics 1: An Introduction by Audrey Grant (Better Bridge). ABTA's Software of the Year Award went to Mike Lawrence's The Two Over One System. This CD program utilizes Fred Gitelman's excellent Bridge Base software.

The ABTA's Applebasket Award for best bridge teaching tip of the year was presented to Leslie Shafer of Silver Spring MD.

Four ABTA members were awarded the prestigious "Master Teacher" status: Richard Braunstein of West Hempstead NY; Liz Randall of Point Jefferson NY; Judi Schulman of Albany NY and Peggy Tatro of San Rafael CA.

In other news, the ABTA presented a Lifetime Achievement Award to Harry Lampert. Lampert is the author of many best-selling bridge books including his latest, The Fun Way to Bridge Play. He is also a past president of the ABTA and creator of the "Flash" comic book character. When Lampert retired from his career as a professional cartoonist in the mid-Seventies, he found a new calling as a bridge teacher and author. Lampert created the ABTA logo and has served as staff artist for the organization for more than 25 years. He is an ACBL Life Master as well as an ABTA Master Teacher.

Women begin battle for Wagar Trophy

The Wagar Women's Knockout Teams gets under way today. At stake is the Wagar Trophy, which honors one of the all-time great players.

Margaret Wagar (1902-1990), inducted into the ACBL Bridge Hall of Fame in 1999, became Life Master #37 in 1943, the fifth woman to earn the rank. She and Kay Rhodes share one of the most remarkable achievements in ACBL history — they won the Women's Pairs four consecutive years — 1955, 1956, 1957 and 1958.

Wagar and Rhodes share another record — one of frustration. They were second in the Women's Teams for seven consecutive years, 1952-1958.

Wagar's impressive record spans three decades and includes wins in women's and open competition. Her open wins include the Reisinger in 1941, the Open Pairs (the forerunner of the Blue Ribbon Pairs) in 1947 and 1948 and the Spingold in 1946 and 1948.

Wagar served on the ACBL Board of Directors from 1960 to 1972 and was named ACBL Honorary Member in 1979. She was non-playing captain of the U.S. World Women's Teams in 1968 and 1972.

Six-four: bid some more

Last year's final between teams captained by Kathie Wei-Sender (Betty Ann Kennedy, Jill Levin-Sue Picus, Janice Seamon-Molson-Tobi Sokolow) and Cheri Bjerkan (Stasha Cohen, Pam Wittes, Renee Mancuso, Lynn Deas, Beth Palmer) featured several lead changes along with aggressive bidding and play.

with on those long airplane flights? "I played with Wally Moon, Jim Gilliam and Don Drysdale. That was back in the days of Drysdale and Sandy Koufax. We won the World Series in 1965 when we beat the Minnesota Twins."

Parker is playing in the 199er games here. How come if he was playing bridge back in the Sixties? "I couldn't stand the smoke, and most bridge players were smokers back in those days. I played duplicate for about three years, but then I gave it up for about 30 years. There are new rules about smoking now, so I returned to the game about two years ago. Another reason why I returned - I have more time these days."

He says he's 63, but he looks more like 35. He's a fierce competitor, but he's still looking for his first bridge Golden Glove.

The defenders appeared to get off to a good start when they took the first two tricks in hearts. At trick three, West shifted to a low club. Zia went up with dummy's ♣K, which held, and he followed with the ♠J, covered by the queen and king.

Had Zia played a second trump, he would have gone down. East could ruff the third round of diamonds and Zia would be left with two club losers.

Zia had noticed, however, that East had found it very easy to cover the ♠J. Zia also noted that East bid only 2♥. With three or four hearts, East might have jumped preemptively. Zia deduced correctly that East was 4-2 in the majors.

Zia therefore abandoned trumps, playing on diamonds right away. East ruffed the third round, but Zia overruffed and exited with the ♣Q. West won but could not prevent Zia from ruffing the third round of clubs in dummy.

Rules for being a good partner

By Marty Bergen

I have always believed that your attitude toward your partner is as important as your technical skill at the game. – Rixi Markus, one of the all-time great players.

Before you sit down to discuss what you are playing, you should start your partnership off on the right note. Half the battle of winning is being a good partner. Always observe the following:

1. Do not give lessons – unless you are being paid to do so. *According to an evening paper, there are only five real authorities on bridge in this country. Odd how often one gets one of them as a partner.* Punch (British magazine).

2. Never say anything to your partner unless you would want him to say the same to you. If you are unsure whether your partner would want you to say something, don't.

3. Never "result" (criticize your partner for a normal action just because it did not work this time).

4. Unless your intent is to clear up a misunderstanding, avoid discussing the hand just played. If you cannot resist, be discreet.

5. Remember that you and your partner are on the same side.

6. Do not forget that your partner wants to win just as much as you do.

7. If you feel the urge to be nasty, sarcastic, critical or loud – excuse yourself and take a walk.

8. When there is time between hands, do not discuss bridge.

9. When you want to consult another player about a disaster, ask about your hand, not your partner's.

10. Do not ever criticize or embarrass your partner in front of others.
