Baker, Sanborn hang on for LM Women's triumph

Lynn Baker and Kerri Sanborn took the lead in the second final session of the Life Master Women's Pairs and held on for the win despite a determined charge by Joan Jackson and Robin Klar, the leaders after the first final session.

Baker and Sanborn posted a final score of 1018.22 to 989.45. Their margin of victory was 28.77 matchpoints — top on a board was 25.

Linda McGarry and Laurie Kranyak, who posted a 968.01 total, were third, followed by Gail Bell and Bobbie Gomer, who had 964.54.

Sanborn, a retired stock trader, is a former four-time world champion: World Mixed Pairs in 1978, Venice Cup in 1989 and 1993 and World Women's Pairs in 1990. She has multiple wins in North American events and has also won hundreds of regional titles.

Victory did not come easy against a determined team from China, but the USA I team was finally able to celebrate with a 229.3-210 victory in the Venice Cup final in Monte Carlo earlier this month. America had just missed by a fraction against the Netherlands in the 2000 Venice Cup in Bermuda.

When it was over, Kathie Wei-Sender was happy to congratulate the Chinese players for their good showing, but she breathed a sigh of relief that her proteges didn't play just a little bit better. Wei-Sender has done a lot to promote bridge in China, and she has personally helped the Chinese women's team to climb the international ladder over the years. "They're all my students," she proudly proclaims.

Massuma expressed her political feelings very forcibly. "I hate the Taliban. Most of the people in Afghanistan hate the Taliban. The Taliban is the enemy."

She and Nadine have thoroughly enjoyed playing in the Intermediate-Newcomer area here — they wish they could stay longer. But Massuma is a very busy pediatrician, so they are heading for home today.

They have something to show for their visit to New Orleans — trophies emblematic of winning the 299 Pairs even though they are both 99ers.

Jo Morse and Kyle Larsen posted a strong 65.10% game in the first final session of the Life Master Open Pairs and followed with a 60.37% game to win the event by a little more than one board.

Their final score was 3115.51 to 3014.24 for runners-up Jay Borker and Fred Gitelman. Top on a board was 90.

Close behind in third place were Nels Erickson and Chris Larsen, who posted a 3001.16 total.

Fourth, with a 2985.48 total, were Howard Weinstein and Zia Mahmood.

Morse and Larsen are both ACBL Grand Life Masters who have won multiple North American championships. Morse won the World Mixed

Successful slam on just 25 points

We returned to our teammates at the half of our second-round KO match Friday evening feeling pretty good. We weren't so happy when our teammates said, "We have to be down at least 40!"

Well, it was swingy, but we wound up ahead by 8 at the half.

My partner and I play a very aggressive light style, which accounts for the bidding on this deal from the second half.

As East, I considered bidding 2NT (not Jacoby) on my first turn, but I didn't. My partner jumped with a hand that she just barely considered an opening bid. I didn't bother to cuebid and went straight to Key Card Blackwood. With two keys and a void partner went directly to slam.

I ruffed the opening club lead and crossed to hand with a diamond. When I led a trump, South rose with the ace and returned a spade. I won this in dummy and led a heart to the king. Another spade let me pull the rest of the trumps. I came to hand with a diamond and led a heart accompanied by a prayer. When the queen came up I was home.

My teammates in this Bracket 3 match were Walter Spiewak, Carol Gorsej-Weinstein and Doug Anderson. We won the match when we managed to stay out of a bad slam two deals later.

Salvage operation

This board from the second qualifying session of the Life Master Open Pairs proved a headache for most North-South pairs.

I can understand North passing a 1♠ opening bid (how likely is your side to make game?), but an auction like 1♠ - 1NT - 2♦ - 2♠ landed most North-South pairs in trouble. And of course East-West can play 3♣ and make it in great comfort. We bid 1♠ - 1NT - 2♦ - 2♥, and this kept East-West out of our auction but landed us in an apparently inelegant spot.

On the ♦J lead, I ducked in dummy, and West had a tough time deciding what to do. Eventually he ducked, so I won the queen and cashed the ♠A-K before the rats got at them. The ♠Q-9 fell on the top honors, so I decided not to ruff a spade low in hand – a good decision.

Now I led a club to the jack and ace and ran the heart return to my hand to ruff a club. I exited from dummy with a spade, pitching my club when West played the ♠10. This was the ending with West on lead and declarer having won five tricks:

The defense can prevail easily enough by playing the ♦A and ruffing a diamond. East exits a club and sits back to wait for his two trump tricks.

However, West chose to play the ♠J, ruffed with the ♥Q, and East now has two winning plays. He can pitch a club – or more elegantly he can underruff. In fact, East overruffed and exited with a club. I ruffed and led a diamond, and best defense is for East to win his ace as East pitches his last club.

In the three-card ending West can lead a master club, but I can throw my diamond away and East is forced to ruff. That forces him to lead a heart into my tenace at trick 12.

Sanborn, regarded as one of the leading women players in the world, had a long and successful partnership with Barry Crane. They were quoted at 2-1 odds against the field in the World Mixed Pairs in 1978 and won the event by five boards.

Sanborn is the last woman to win the McKenney Trophy, now the *Barry Crane Top 500* race. Her victory came in 1974.

Baker, a law professor at the University of Texas, won her first North American title — the Women's Swiss Teams — in 1998. Her collection now includes four other victories plus the Women's International Team Trials in 2001.



From despair to glee

When an over-exuberant partner puts you into a thoroughly bad contract, it is your job to find a way to bring it home if at all possible. 6NT looks hopeless on this deal from the second qualifying session of the Life Master Open Pairs.

English pro Brian Senior was favored with a diamond lead around to his jack – and suddenly the contract proved to be cold!

Unless the ♣J-10 are coming down, a squeeze is required for the 12th trick, and communications are awkward for anything other than a heart-club squeeze. Senior crossed to the ♦K and led a heart, ducking East's 9. Back came the ♥K to the ace, West pitching a diamond.

For a squeeze to operate East must have four clubs with his five hearts, which leaves him with only two spades. So, because a 3-3 spade split means no squeeze and a doomed contract, it is necessary to play for the actual spade position. Senior played the ♠10 to the king, led low back to the ace, cashed the ♦A and hooked the ♠9. East had to give up a club to keep the heart guard and now there were four club tricks and 12 in all. Plus 1440 and a top score on the board.

But, as the Monte Carlo Daily Bulletin pointed out, the teacher still had the edge over her students.

Wei-Sender played with Betty Ann Kennedy, Jill Levin, Sue Picus, Janice Seamon-Molson and Tobi Sokolow. Kent Massie was non-playing captain.

Halfway through the last round, played before a packed vugraph auditorium, China had edged to within 13.3 IMPs with a 6-IMP swing and seemed poised to overtake the Americans. On the next board, USA I engineered an 11-IMP swing when China went four off in 3NT for minus 400 in the closed room while Levin took 10 tricks in 2NT in the open room. This was the deal:

Wenfei's 2♦ showed a weak two-bid in a major. Liping, correctly deducing that partner's suit was spades, started with the ♠J. Wenfei ducked to Levin's king.

The contract was very shaky. Levin could not afford to lose an early trick – if she did she would be down a lot.

At trick two, Levin put the ♣J on the table, covered by North with the queen. Levin took the ♣K and advanced the ♥J, also covered, and she finished with 10 tricks for plus 180.

It might seem to have been an error for North to cover the ♣J at trick two, but Seamon-Molson, defending 3NT in the other room, said she probably would have done the same, reasoning that West was unlikely to have a six-card club suit and that the only chance was for her partner to have four to the 8-7.

Seamon-Molson started with her fourth-best diamond, and Yu Zhang considered her play for a long time before putting in dummy's 10. Sokolow won with the jack and returned the ♠9. Yu played the king, then a club to the king and a club to the jack.

That was a disastrous decision. Seamon-Molson won the ♣Q, cashed her top diamonds (Sokolow discarded a spade on one of them), then played her ♠J to the South hand. Instead of plus 600, declarer was minus 400. It was an 11-IMP swing to USA I instead of a 10-IMP loss. The 21-IMP swing was particularly meaningful in a match won by only 19.3 IMPs.

China managed an 11-IMP swing on the next-to-last board, but by then the margin was too great for them to overcome. The final score was 229.3-210.

In the playoff for the bronze medal, the Netherlands defeated USA II.
