Japanese duo ahead in LM Open Pairs

Two Japanese players held the lead after the first two sessions of the Life Master Open Pairs. In front with two sessions to go were Yoshiyuki Nakamura and Tadashi Yoshida of Tokyo.

In second place, about 22 matchpoints behind, were Howard Weinstein of Chicago and Ralph Katz of Burr Ridge IL.

Another 8 MPs back of the Chicago pair were Kit Woolsey of Kensington CA and Michael Polowan of New York.

Cohen, Wittes lead Life Master Women's

Two players from opposite ends of the country took the lead after two sessions of the Life Master Women's Pairs.

Stasha Cohen of Glen Ridge NJ and Pam Wittes of Los Alamitos CA scored 2096.66 over two sessions to lead by more than 18 matchpoints.

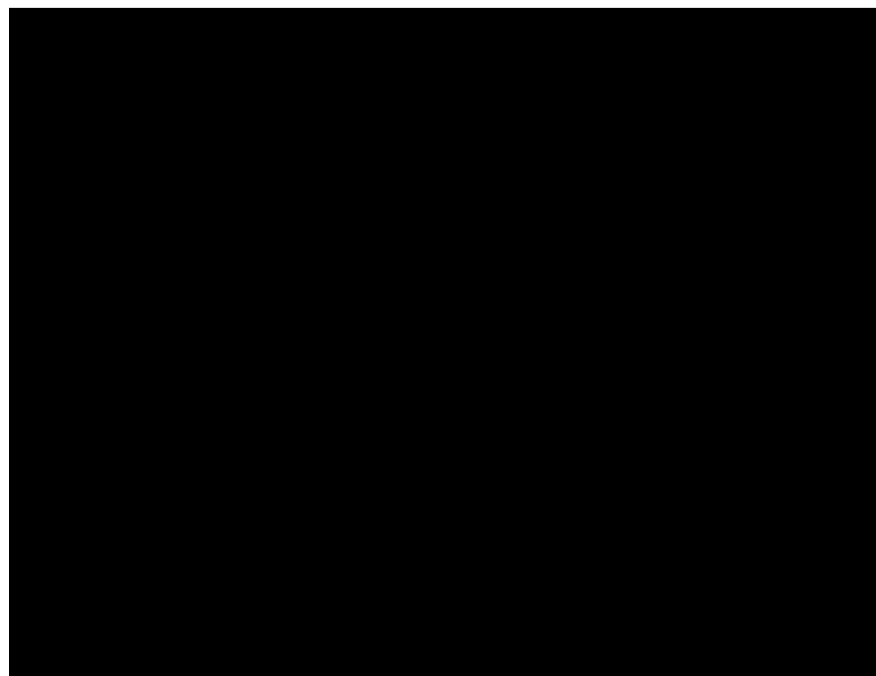
In second place were Linda Green and Marianne Spanier of Scottsdale AZ. Well back in third place, 112 MPs out of second and more than 130 out of first, were Diana Schuld of Glen Head NY and Cynthia Hinckley of Guayanabo, Puerto Rico.

Two Bay Area pairs held the top spots after two qualifying sessions of the Non-Life Master Pairs. In first by about 11 matchpoints were Alan Hamilton of Berkeley and Molly Holsford of Oakland.

In second place with two sessions to go were Carol Sanna of Danville and Cecelia Zachar of Berkeley.

In third place were Shawn Cantlin of Tracy CA and Mary Olson of Randolph NJ.

American women dedicate Olympiad win to Perlstein

The new World Olympiad Women's Team champions from the United States added many dimensions to the concept of victory. They offered a dedication, featured a mother-daughter combination, and transformed a former world champion chess player into a world champion bridge player.

The Americans came from behind with a torrid third set to defeat China 268-198, in the 96-board final in Rhodes, Greece, last month.

On the victorious team were Gail Greenberg, Jill Blanchard, Irina Levitina, Lynn Deas, Juanita Chambers and Shawn Quinn. Their captain was Eddie Wold, with Bob Morris as coach.

They defeated a powerful Chinese squad that had obliterated Canada in one

of the semifinals. Playing for China were Gu Ling, Zhang Ya Lan, Sun Ming, Wang Hong Li, Wang Wen Fei and Zhang Yu, with Zhang Wei Li as non-playing captain. Several of these players are well-known to regulars at North American Championships -- they have been strong contenders in many events on several occasions.

Canada won the bronze medal by defeating Austria, 133-67. Playing for Canada were Sharyn Reus, Dianna Gordon, Barbara Saltsman, Beverly Kraft, Rhoda Habert and Francine Cimon, with George Holland as non-playing captain.

Tribute to Lila Perlstein

This victory was special for the Americans in many ways. First and

You get your chance to try the Classic Bridge game today

If you plan to play in the stratified portion of today's Stratiflighted Pairs (Strats B, C and D, which will take place at the St. Francis Hotel), you will have the opportunity to play Classic Bridge. Sections of Classic Bridge will be set up.

When you play Classic Bridge, you don't have to worry about several of the things that come up in other sections. For instance, there are NO ALERTS! Second, the number of conventions allowed is very limited.

Of course, if you prefer to use your personal set of special conventions, you can still play in one of the other sections. But if you want a good simple game without the bother of Alerts and all kinds of difficult-to-understand conventions, then the Classic game is the one for you.

Here is a breakdown of what you can and can't play in the Classic game.

Opening bids

INT: Any contiguous range of 3 points with a lower value of not less than 11 and an upper value of not greater than 19.

Opening bids of one of a suit may be 4- or 5-card major style and must not be substantially lighter than what would be deemed "standard" but may be somewhat lighter.

Opening bids of one of a minor must promise 3 or more cards in either suit.

Good opening day

San Francisco 1996 made a good start toward becoming the biggest NABC in San Francisco history yesterday. The total turnout was 1385.5 tables. The record for which we're shooting is 13,239, set in 1990.

The afternoon session was especially large -- 664.5 tables. Included in this total were 107 Novice tables.

Since Thursday evening also was big -- 203 tables -- the total to date is a very healthy 1588.5 tables.

Japanese contingent evident at NABC

Last summer, the ACBL accepted an invitation to publicize the 1996 Fall NABC in the official publication of the Japanese Contract Bridge League.

That modest encouragement for Japanese players to attend the San Francisco tournament has borne fruit as nearly three dozen are in attendance -- and two Japanese players were leading the Life Master Open Pairs going into today's final two sessions.

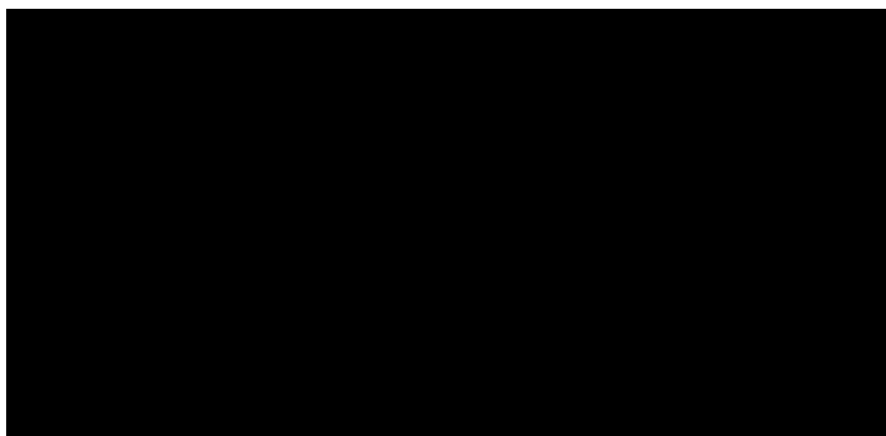
The impetus for the ACBL-JCBL contact came from Toyoko Shibutani, an ACBL player who lives in the New York City area. Shibutani acted as liai-

son between the two bridge organizations.

Shibutani, an American, has been an ambassador for the ACBL among Japanese players who work in the U.S. As a member of the Nippon Club, which has an ACBL-sanctioned bridge game, Shibutani encourages the Japanese players to join the ACBL and to maintain their memberships when they return to Japan.

Eight of the Japanese players attending the Fall NABC came to San Francisco from New York and were

Guts -- and glory

On this deal from the Charity Knockout Teams Friday morning, Roger Lord's partner, Alex Kolesnik of Austin TX, correctly inferred an opponent's trump holding. Accordingly, he took an anti-percentage finesse that resulted in a 10-IMP pickup.

West opened the ♣6. East took the ace and returned the 8. Kolesnik finessed and West won the queen. West then switched to the ♦A, received the encouraging jack from East, and continued a diamond, forcing dummy to ruff.

Declarer's need to ruff another diamond prevented him from playing two high trumps to discover the 4-1 trump break before finessing for the jack. Had he played two high trumps, he would not have been able to use dummy's last trump for ruffing a diamond and finessing.

After cashing the ♠A, Kolesnik made the winning play -- a second-round finesse of the ♠10. Next, he ruffed a diamond, returned to hand with a club to the king, drew trumps and claimed with a good club and the top hearts.

Kolesnik reasoned that West might have made those unusual plays in diamonds in the hope that partner would wind up with a trump trick. The switch and continuation might have been essential for the defense if, for example, South had held the singleton ♥Q.

In Lord's mind, besides his astute reasoning, Kolesnik needed and found the additional ingredient for risking the loss of a trump trick to J-x or J-x-x -- courage!

foremost, the team dedicated their triumph to the late Lila Perlstein, the woman who put the team together and played on it until death claimed her earlier this year.

"She was a beautiful woman, a very special lady," said Greenberg. "She played hard with us while she fought her illness, but she wasn't able to live long enough to share this victory with us." After receiving her gold medal, Greenberg stepped up to the podium at the Victory Banquet and paid a tribute to Perlstein.

Mother-daughter combo

Switching from sadness to joy, Greenberg told of the special thrill this triumph provided. "I've won world championships before, but they all dim to nothingness compared to winning on a team with my daughter -- my adorable little baby Jill. What a thrilling experience!"

"Winning this championship was special because I was playing on the same team as my mother," said Blanchard.

Mother and daughter did not play as a partnership in Rhodes, but they were partners quite frequently during the Team Trials.

Chambers pointed out that the Rhodes triumph amounted to a three-peat. "We've won every knockout match we've played as a team. It started at the Summer Championships in New Orleans, followed by the Trials and now here."

The Americans were winners from start to finish. They topped their group in the round-robin, defeated the Netherlands, 151-101, in the quarterfinals and eliminated defending champion Austria, 246-223, in the semifinals.

Strange coincidence

A strange coincidence: the team they beat in New Orleans also was China, which had four of the same players as in Rhodes. And back in September at the Marlboro China Cup in Beijing, Deas and Chambers won the Cup by defeating -- you guessed it -- the Chinese women in the final.

And what's this about a chess champion? That's right -- Levitina was a world champion chess player when she resided in Russia. For her it was a dream come true. "I guess it's every bridge player's dream, but I'm one of the lucky ones."

Greenberg has been a member of all three victorious American teams in Women's Olympiads -- 1980, 1984 and 1996.

The crucial set

After the first day's play (32 boards), China led by 20. By the time the third set was over, American led by 46. And China never threatened again. The turnaround began on the very first board of the set.

Levitina and Zhang Ya Lan both opened the North hand 1♦ and both Wang Hong Li and Chambers over-called 1♠. Blanchard and Gu Ling both jumped to 4♥,

and both Sun Ming and Deas bid 4♠. In one room Levitina passed and Blanchard doubled; in the other Zhang doubled.

Gu led the ♥K and Chambers tried dummy's ♦J at trick two. Zhang won the queen and led a trump, won in dummy and a low diamond was led. Zhang went in with the 10 and played a second trump. The ♦K-9, however, were worth a trick via the ruffing finesse. That provided the game-going trick for Chambers.

Blanchard found the good lead of a low trump, and Wang won in hand to lead the ♦8. Blanchard ruffed, protecting her partner's diamond holding, then switched to a club. When Levitina gained the lead, she played a second trump, leaving declarer a trick short -- minus 100 -- plus 590 and 12 IMPs to the Americans.

East's diamond spots are significant. If declarer had led the 4 instead of the 8, she could have prevailed by setting up a diamond trick in dummy with ruffing finesses. If South made the same play of ruffing and leading a club, the ♦8 would play a significant role in setting up a diamond trick in dummy for the 10th trick.

If South discarded and North let her ruff the second diamond, then North could not obtain the lead to push a second trump and declarer would enjoy three heart ruffs in dummy. If South discarded and North won to lead a second trump, then declarer could eventually set up a diamond trick in dummy.

The first board of the fourth set ended any hopes China still had. The Chinese were down 46 at the time and needed some favorable swings. But 12 IMPs went America's way instead.

After two top spades, Deas switched to a diamond. Zhang rose with the ace, but of course the contract was hopeless. Eventually Zhang was down four -- minus 800 and 12 IMPs to the Americans, who now led by 58.

American gains of 7 of Board 51, 8 on 54, 8 on 55 and 9 on 58 put the match beyond reach -- the Americans were Olympiad champions! □

Feldman team wins silver in World Mixed Teams

A last-minute pickup team made up of two Britons and four Icelanders won the World Mixed Teams in Rhodes, Greece, last month. They defeated an American team captained by Mark Feldman in a hard-fought final, 66-55.

Playing with Feldman were Sharon Osberg plus Bill and Rozanne Pollack. Osberg has two Venice Cup championships to her credit. Rozanne won the McConnell Teams in 1994 and placed second in the Venice Cup last year.

The winners were Heather Dhondy and Elizabeth McGowan of Great Britain plus Icelanders Jon Baldursson, Adalsteinn Jorgensen, Bjorn Eysteinnsson and Ragnar Hermansson. Baldursson and Jorgensen were partners for the victorious Iceland team in the 1991 Bermuda Bowl in 1991, Eysteinnsson was the non-playing captain, and Hermansson was the coach.

Here's how the two-country team got together. The Icelanders had just been eliminated in the Olympiad quarterfinals and they were drowning their sorrows at the bar. Their friend Hjordis Eythorsdottir offered to cheer them up by finding them teammates for the Mixed Teams. At 2:30 am she found Dhondy and McGowan -- and a gold medal team was formed.

They were first all the way, placing on top in the endless Swiss that preceded the semifinals and final.

Helgemo of Norway Personality of Year

Geir Helgemo of Norway was named 1996 Bridge Personality of the Year by the International Bridge Press Association in Rhodes, Greece.

In the course of the last 18 months, Helgemo has won the World Junior Pairs (with Boye Brogeland), the Cap Volmac Pairs (with Tor Helness) and the Generali World Men's Individual. In addition he has put together a good string of results in ACBL North American Championships (notably Miami Beach).

He and Tor Helness are one of the strongest pairs in the world. But Helgemo has also impressed everyone as a pleasant opponent and a cheerful companion.

Here is a nice defense by Helgemo taken from this Olympiad:

Helgemo led the ♠8 to the queen and ace. East played the ♣2 (showing attitude) to North's ace. Declarer then led the ♦A, ♦K and another diamond to Helgemo's 10. Now put yourself in West's chair, and imagine that you are in. You probably feel like switching to a small heart, don't you?

Let's enter Helgemo's mind for a second, and see what makes him such an outstanding player. He knew that East had a club honor, but it would make a difference if it was the king or the queen. Suppose South held both the black kings.

A low heart would then bring South in on the queen. He could then cash both his black kings, play a heart to the 10 and exit with another diamond.

And -- oops, West is endplayed, left with only hearts. South will have won his contract. This was not the layout of the hand, so in this case it would have been sufficient to play a small heart. But Helgemo, of course, did not know that. In order to cater for South having both the black kings, he played the ♥K!! This doesn't only bring dummy in too early, but it also lays the foundation for two down, instead of one, which you will get if you play a small heart.

Responding to 1NT

2♣ = Stayman (check for 4-card or longer major suit). Restriction: 2NT is always natural and invitational.

Two of any other suit: Option 1) signoff, natural. Option 2) Jacoby transfer (2♦ shows 5 or more hearts, 2♥ shows five or more spades).

Follow-ups to the transfer must be at least game-invitational and should be discussed so that both members of the partnership agree whether the bid of a new suit is forcing or invitational. 2♠ is game-forcing with exact meaning at the discretion of the partnership (must specify). Option 3) two-way Stayman (2♦ is game-forcing Stayman).

Three of any suit: Option 1) Natural, invitational or better. Option 2) Minors or majors or both designated as invitational or better.

4♥ and 4♠: Option 1) To play (if not playing Texas transfers). Option 2) Texas transfer (4♦ shows 6 or more hearts, 4♥ shows 6 or more spades).

Over double: Transfers may or may not apply. Over clubs: If natural, transfers may or may not apply; if Landy (takeout for major suits), transfers do not apply.

Over other bids: Double is negative or penalty (must specify) and all bids are natural, including 2NT.

Responding to a major opening

Option 1) Double raise forcing. Option 2) Double raise limit (invitational to game). Option 3) 2NT Jacoby game-forcing raise. Option 4) 3NT game-forcing raise. Option 5) Splinter (double jump shift game forcing with singleton or void in suit bid).

In competition, double raise is limit, cuebid is forcing raise; over takeout double, jump raise can be limit, preemptive (weak) or forcing (must specify).

Optional conventions: 1NT forcing; Drury or reverse Drury (2♣ by responder inquires about the soundness of a third- or fourth-seat opening bid).

Responding to a minor opening

Double raise is forcing or limit (must specify). 2NT is natural and forcing or invitational (must specify). In competition, double raise is limit or forcing, cuebid is raise.

Opener's rebids

Splinters are allowed.

Responder's rebids

Option 1) New suit forcing; fourth suit can be used as a "convenience bid." Option 2) Either a new minor or a club bid can be used over either 1NT or 2NT as a checkback for a major-suit fit.

Opening two-bids

Weak twos: 2♣ is any strong hand, 2♦ response is artificial.

2♦, 2♥ or 2♠ is weak (high-card point range to be specified). Range contained from 5-11 HCP. Minimum five-card suit. 2NT response shows invitational or better values. Specify meanings of opener's rebids. New-suit response may be forcing or non-forcing (must specify on card). Over new suit, opener must be allowed to raise (pairs whose opener fails to raise a psyched new suit with a hand appropriate for a raise will be penalized).

Strong twos: 2♣ is a strong hand (natural or artificial), 2♦ response is artificial. 2♦, 2♥, 2♠ are natural and forcing to the three level.

2NT opening: Any 2- or 3-point contiguous range, subject to a minimum of 19 points. 3♣ response = Stayman. Option 1) Jacoby transfer and Texas transfers and 3♠ artificial are allowed. Option 2) Gerber.

Notrump overcalls

Cheapest notrump overcall: any contiguous range

up to 4 HCP, specified for both a direct and a balancing notrump overcall.

Cuebid is Stayman, two-level suits are signoffs, three-level suit bids are forcing.

Jump to 2NT is either for minors or two lowest unbid suits (must specify whether playing minors or two lowest unbid suits on convention card).

Negative doubles

If playing negative doubles, must specify on convention card the level through which they are played, with a maximum level of 4♦. Negative doubles show values to compete and either both unbid suits or one unbid suit (usually a major) and tolerance for opener's suit.

Overcalls

New suit forcing or not forcing, must specify on convention card. Cuebid shows support for the overcalled suit and invitational or better hand, or any very strong hand that need not have support.

Jump raise is forcing, limit or preemptive (weak) (must specify).

Over an opponent's notrump

All bids natural. Option: 2♣ shows both majors (Landy).

Jump overcalls

Must specify on convention card: Option 1) Preemptive (weak hand, long suit). Option 2) Intermediate (strength of a sound opening bid with a long, good suit). Option 3) Strong (very strong hand with long suit).

Direct cuebid

Over minors: natural, or strong takeout, or shows two known suits. Over majors: strong takeout, or shows two known suits. Michaels cuebid (showing the other major and an unknown minor) is not acceptable.

Slam conventions

4NT Blackwood: responses are 5♣ = zero or 4, 5♦ = 1, etc. Option: Jump to 5NT is grand slam force. 4NT Roman Key Card Blackwood: All responses allowed.

Defensive carding

Leads are fourth-best from length, high from x-x-x or x-x-x-x vs. notrump.

Circle card led from x-x-x vs. suits.

Standard signals (high card encourages, or shows even number, or high suit preference).

Lead king from A-K-x, or ace from A-K-x, otherwise top of any sequence of honors (including interior sequence). Exception: Lead queen from K-Q-10-9 vs. notrump (optional).

Specific exclusions

Psychs are strongly discouraged. □

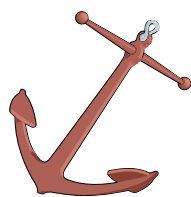

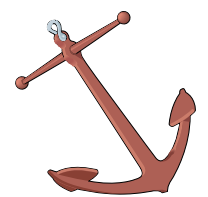

Bridge Hall of Fame will add six members

The Bridge Hall of Fame will add six new members in 1997, swelling the ranks of officially acknowledged bridge immortals to 31.

The new Hall of Fame members will be selected in balloting by a group of electors, currently totaling more than 900 -- Diamond (and higher-ranked) Life Masters, North American members of the International Bridge Press Association, members and past members of the ACBL Board of Directors, current members of the ACBL Board of Governors and all ACBL Honorary Members of the Year.

Ballots will be mailed on Dec. 9 and must be returned to ACBL postmarked no later than Jan. 13, 1997. Each elector's player number must appear either on the reverse of the return envelope or on the ballot itself in order for the ballot to be valid.

Induction ceremonies for the six new members are scheduled for March 6 in Dallas, just prior to the start of the 1997 Spring NABC.

The Bridge Hall of Fame, which contains portraits of all members, is located on the fourth floor of the ACBL Headquarters building in Memphis.

Elections to the Hall of Fame are conducted annually. Suggestions for nominations are welcome. You may write to the Bridge Hall of Fame Committee, care of the ACBL, 2990 Airways Blvd., Memphis TN 38116-3847.

Twenty-five already in

Hall of Fame members are: Ely Culbertson, Charles Goren and Harold Vanderbilt, elected in 1964; Oswald Jacoby, Sidney Lenz and Milton Work, 1965; Howard Schenken, Sidney Silodor and Waldemar von Zedtwitz, 1966; B. Jay Becker, Easley Blackwood, Barry Crane, John Crawford, Edgar Kaplan, Alvin Roth, Helen Sobel Smith and Bobby Wolff, 1995; Josephine Culbertson, Eddie Kantar, Norman Kay, Victor Mitchell, Alfred Sheinwold and Sam Stayman -- plus P. Hal Sims and Albert H. Morehead, the recipients, respectively, of the *von Zedtwitz* and *Blackwood* awards, 1996.

Nominees

Three members each will be selected from a group of 16 living and 19 deceased candidates. The living candidates:

Mary Jane Farell -- Four-time world champion, 14-time NABC winner, WBF Grand Master, ACBL Grand Life Master. Her 1978 win (with Marilyn Johnson) of the Life Master Pairs is the only time the six-session event has been won by two women. With the death of Hermine Baron earlier this year, Farell became ACBL's leading masterpoint holder among women.

Edith Kemp Freilich -- One of only two women (Helen Sobel Smith was the other) who have won all three major open team championships -- the Reisinger (formerly the Chicago), Spingold and Vanderbilt. She won the Spingold and Vanderbilt the same year -- 1963. WBF World Master and ACBL Grand Life Master, she has won 29 NABC titles.

Frederick Hamilton -- Hamilton won the Bermuda Bowl in 1976 and the World Senior Pairs in 1994. WBF Grand Master and ACBL Grand Life Master, he ranks 8th on the all-time masterpoint list.

Robert Jordan -- He and partner Arthur Robinson were thought by many to be the best American partnership in the Sixties. Second in the Bermuda Bowl in 1963, he won seven NABC titles.

Sami R. Kehela -- He and partner Eric Murray are the only pair in the world to represent their country (Canada) in the World Team Olympiad from its inception in 1960 thru 1988 (missing only 1984). Their partnership lasted for more than 30 years.

Sidney H. Lazard -- WBF Life Master and ACBL Grand Life Master, he was second in the Bermuda Bowl in 1959 and third in 1969. He has won 10 NABC championships.

Peter A. Leventritt -- ACBL president 1954

and past president of the Card School of New York, which he co-founded. Leventritt won 13 NABC titles and was second in the Bermuda Bowl four times. He pioneered the use of the Schenken system in partnership with its inventor.

Marshall Miles -- WBF World Master, ACBL Grand Life Master and a regular columnist for the *ACBL Bridge Bulletin*. His books include *How to Win at Duplicate Bridge*, *All 52 Cards* and *Bridge from the Top, Books I and II*.

Eric R. Murray -- Represented North America in the Bermuda Bowl in 1962, 1966, 1967 and 1974, finishing second each time, and represented Canada in other world competitions. He devised the Murray 2♦ convention and co-authored the Drury convention.

George Rapée -- Life Master #44, inventor of the Stayman convention and Bermuda Bowl champion in 1950, 1951 and 1953. Rapée had the best record of success in the three major team championships for the years 1942-80, winning 21 and finishing second in 18.

William S. Root -- Considered by many to be the foremost teacher of bridge, his bridge cruises have become legendary. He has represented ACBL in international competition and has 13 NABC wins.

George Rosenkranz -- Mexico's first Life Master is now an ACBL Grand Life Master and a WBF World Master. He was the ACBL Honorary Member in 1990.

Ira S. Rubin -- Bermuda Bowl winner in 1976, Rubin invented Rubin transfers, two-way two-bids, gladiator responses to notrump and extended Landy.

Thomas K. Sanders -- ACBL president in 1986, WBF World Master and ACBL Grand Life Master. Sanders is the only graduate of Vanderbilt University to win the Vanderbilt Trophy. He has won 11 NABC titles and was non-playing captain of the 1981 Bermuda Bowl champions.

Tobias Stone -- A international backgammon champion and co-inventor of the Roth-Stone system, he and partner Al Roth were the first Americans to win the Deauville Invitational pair event, which they took with a record-breaking 82% game.

Dorothy Hayden Truscott -- Truscott and Helen Sobel Smith are the only two women to have played on the North American team for the Bermuda Bowl. Truscott finished second in the Bermuda Bowl in 1965 and placed third in the World Open Pairs in 1966, the only woman ever to finish in the top 10 in this event. She has won four world titles and more than 25 NABC titles. Truscott is the author of two bridge classics: *Bid Better, Play Better*, and *Winning Declarer Play*.

Deceased nominees

David Bruce (formerly Burnstine) -- Life Master #1 and a member of three outstanding teams: the Four Horsemen, the Bid-Rite Team and the Four Aces. An all-round star, Burnstine was rated by many of his teammates as the best bidder in the game. His tournament record includes a victory in the first official World Championship in 1935 and more than 25 national championships.

Ira G. Corn Jr. -- ACBL president in 1980, he organized, financed and captained the Aces, the world's first professional bridge team, which won the world championship in 1970 and 1971. The last Aces team Corn put together won the 1982 Spingold in July after his death in April and went on to defeat Italy in the 1983 Bermuda Bowl.

Harry J. Fishbein -- President of New York's Mayfair Club and author of the Fishbein convention. Won 17 national titles and placed second 19 times. ACBL Honorary Member in 1966.

Richard L. Frey -- Life Master #8, editor of the *ACBL Bulletin* 1958-1970, editor-in-chief of the first three editions of the *Official Encyclopedia of Bridge* and editor of 12 *World Championship Books*.

Sam Fry Jr. -- Life Master #10 -- at 26 years old, the youngest of the 10. Writings include a modern edition of Watson's *Play of the Hand at Bridge*. He won nine national championships.

John Gerber -- Inventor of the Gerber 4♣ ace-asking convention. He represented North America as a player and as non-playing captain in Bermuda Bowl competitions.

Michael Gottlieb -- Life Master #9, Gottlieb early established a reputation as a champion, winning nine major national titles from 1929 to 1936. He was a key member of the Four Aces team that included Howard Schenken, Oswald Jacoby, David Burnstine and Richard Frey.

Emma Jean Hawes -- At the time of her death in 1987, Hawes was one of only eight women WBF Grand Masters. She won the Venice Trophy in 1974, 1976 and 1978 and the World Olympiad Women's Teams in 1980. She won 11 NABC titles.

Lee Hazen -- A driving force in the modernization of ACBL in the late Forties, Hazen served as ACBL counsel 1942-85 and ACBL vice president 1945-47. He was named Honorary Member of the Year in 1958.

James Jacoby -- A WBF Grand Master and an ACBL Grand Life Master, Jacoby won the Bermuda Bowl in 1970 and 1971, the World Mixed Teams in 1972 and the World Team Olympiad in 1988. He won 14 NABC titles.

Alvin Landy -- Life Master #24 and ACBL top executive from 1950 until his death in 1967. ACBL Honorary Member in 1957. He helped found the WBF and was one of the original officers.

Theodore A. Lightner -- Life Master #7 and a Bermuda Bowl winner in 1953. Inventor of the Lightner double of slam contracts.

Lewis L. Mathe -- ACBL president in 1975, Bermuda Bowl winner in 1954. He won 19 NABC championships.

Alphonse Moysse Jr. -- Editor and publisher of *The Bridge World* 1956-66. He was the first American to be named IBPA Honorary Member.

Peter Pender -- Bermuda Bowl winner in 1985, Pender was an ACBL Grand Life Master who won 14 NABC titles. He won the McKenney Trophy (now the *Barry Crane Top 500*) in 1966, the same year he helped England's Jeremy Flint become a Life Master in a then-record 11 weeks.

Alexander M. (Al) Sobel -- Sobel won his greatest fame as a director of bridge tournaments, but he was also noted as a writer, quizmaster and wit. He became a member of the ACBL Laws Commission in 1943, was the first Honorary Member of the Japan Contract Bridge League and was ACBL Honorary Member in 1949. He was the third North American Championships Tournament Manager for the ACBL, following Alfred M. Gruenther and Russell Baldwin.

Charles J. Solomon -- Life Master #16, he won 12 national titles and represented the U.S. in international competition. Solomon was ACBL president in 1958 and ACBL Honorary Member in 1961. He helped found the World Bridge Federation and served as WBF vice president 1958-1964, as president 1964-1968, as chairman of the Board 1968-1972 and as honorary chairman from 1972 until his death.

Margaret Wagar -- Life Master #37, a member of the ACBL Board of Directors from 1960 to 1972 and ACBL Honorary Member in 1979. With Kay Rhodes, she shared one of the most remarkable achievements in ACBL history -- they won the Women's Pairs four consecutive years: 1955 through 1958. Wagar won 21 additional NABC events.

Sally Young -- Life Master #17, the first woman to earn Life Master status. Young won 22 NABC titles and was a member of the only all-women's team to win a major open title (the 1947 Chicago, now the Reisinger). □

Clubbed into submission

Adam Wildavsky of Jackson Heights NY had to do some card reading on this deal from the first qualifying session of the Life Master Open Pairs -- and he was up to the task. Wildavsky was playing with Steve Beatty of Destrehan LA.

South led the ♠6. Wildavsky put up the 7, then overtook with the 10 to play a diamond from his hand. South could not afford to rise with his ace, so he played low. The ♦Q won in dummy, and Wildavsky followed with five rounds of clubs. South had two easy pitches on clubs three and four -- a low diamond and a low spade -- but when Wildavsky cashed the 13th club, South faced a Hobson's choice.

South was stuck. Pitching a spade would allow Wildavsky to enjoy a cheap extra trick in that suit. If South threw a diamond, Wildavsky could then play a low diamond from his hand, promoting his king to a winner when the ♦A beat air. Finally, a heart discard would allow Wildavsky to cash the ♥A and follow with the ♠A and another spade. After cashing a second spade trick, South would be forced to cash or lead away from his ♦A, either play giving Wildavsky that vital overtrick.

In practice, South discarded a diamond and Wildavsky chalked up plus 630, good for 41 out of 51 matchpoints.

Trump tricks

Two deals from the Charity Stratified Open Pairs produced some neat maneuvers with the spade suit as trumps. They may only have been partscores, but every trick counted.

It is not often that two hands with a combined 19 high-card points have such excellent play for game, but on this deal North-South belong in game. Not surprisingly, however, the majority of pairs missed that good spot. The key to the deal was thus trying to squeeze overtricks out of the deal.

On the lead of a heart to the king, followed by the ♣K and another heart, there was a strong inference that West needed the ♠Q for his bidding. So the winning line of play is to ruff the heart, play a diamond to dummy and run the ♠J. Then ruff a club and draw trump, making plus 200 for 10 out of 12 matchpoints.

On the companion board, 4♠ again was a contract with some play, but my partner and I wisely stopped low.

East did well to lead the ♣K -- the play is easier on a diamond lead. I won with dummy's ♣A and had to consider the real possibility that trumps were 4-1 (when a preemptor lead his own suit, he rarely has a side-suit singleton and thus often has a singleton trump).

I led a heart to the 10, cashed the ♥A and the ♠A and played the ♥K, pitching a club. It was disappointing that East ruffed, but when she exited with a club, I ruffed and led a diamond to the queen and ace. I then played a low diamond from dummy and West (guarding against his partner's holding ♦Q J doubleton) ducked.

That was an error. The best defense was to take the ♦K, cash the ♠K -- reducing my hand to the ♠J -- and play the ♥Q, forcing me to ruff, mak-
